Alameda County Public Health Department Resumes H1N1 Vaccination Effort December 12

Five Vaccination Clinics Scheduled Countywide for Residents at Highest Risk of Complications

Oakland, CA – The Alameda County Public Health Department announced today the H1N1 vaccination clinic schedule for Saturday, December 12. All clinics will operate from 9 am to 1 pm, or until supply depletes.

Due to the continued nationwide shortage, the H1N1 vaccine is only available to individuals who live in Alameda County and who are at highest-risk of complications from exposure to the H1N1 virus, including:

- Pregnant women
- Persons who live with or provide care for infants under the age of 6 months (e.g., parents, siblings and childcare providers)
- Children and young adults aged 6 months – 24 years (Note: Children 9 years of age and under will need a second of vaccine in at least 3 – 4 weeks)
- All other persons aged 25 – 64 who have chronic medical conditions that put them at higher risk for flu-related complications

Individuals who do not meet these high-risk guidelines will not receive the vaccine. Unfortunately, there will be no exceptions.

The H1N1 vaccine continues to be distributed in limited quantities to healthcare providers by the state. Residents can contact their healthcare provider to determine availability or for guidance related to the H1N1 vaccine.
